During the Walk for Life ceremony, participants will be given a small baggy that has purple powder in it, and the students will throw the purple powder up in the air. The powder is made with high quality cornstarch and food dyes. All materials are 100% FD&C and/or D&C grade and approved by the US FDA. However, the powder is not designed for consumption. Although all the materials are food grade, we do not recommend inhaling large quantities of color powder. Anyone who has asthma, is allergic to any of the ingredients or has any respiratory issues should exercise caution when participating in color powder events. The color powder washes out of most clothing. However, it can stain some materials. 100% cotton clothing is recommended and typical machine washing with stain remover, removes the stains. We recommend removing excess powder from clothing, skin and hair before washing and/or applying water. Normal soap and water should remove color powder from skin and hair. Some color does tend to linger for a few days especially on blonde hair. If you are worried about staining, we recommend applying a moisturizer to skin and coating your hair with a small amount of coconut or olive oil before the event. Before powder is thrown up in the air, students who do not wish to participate in the powder throw will be given an opportunity to move to the side of the stadium.
